1. PIPFA Syllabus 2019 PRAD will be effective from Winter 2019 (July 2019).
2. PIPFA Syllabus 2019 for Pakistan Railways Accounts Department (PRAD) will be applicable to all nominees of PRAD registered in Winter-18 and Summer-19.
3. Those students who were registered in PIPFA upto Summer 2018 and have already appeared in exam who could not qualify by Summer-18 session will be eligible to appear in PIPFA Exam under PIPFA Syllabus for Public Sector 2015 till PIPFA Exam Winter 2019; failing which they would automatically stand switched over to PIPFA Syllabus for PRAD 2019.
4. The paper of Audit Assurance (PS) will be without books from Winter-2019 onwards for CGA and PRAD students under new syllabus 2019 for Pakistan railways account Department (PRAD).
